VI. School Leaders' Report

- Our current enrollment stands at 549 students as of today, with a target of 552.
- We have received 954 new student applications for the 2024-25 school year as of today.
- For the upcoming school year, we have successfully received 104 out of 107 enrollment packets.
- We have commenced the Summer Institute (Professional Development) with all staff members.

VII. Business Administrator's Report

• Financial Statements (Exhibit II)

- As of June 30, the cash balance is \$769,879 with a current ratio of 2.12 (benchmark = 2).
- School district receivables for the current year stand at \$658,590. Cash on hand covers 28.86 days.
- As of June 30 (roughly 100% through the fiscal year), we recognized 103% of budgeted revenue and 106% of budgeted expenses (per the 2023-24 budget), resulting in a net loss of \$191,955.
- School district revenue is coming in at 91% of the budgeted amount, with William Penn School District contributing significantly fewer students than budgeted.
- We hired four new staff members over the summer:
 - Briana Amaya (Special Education Teacher)
 - Gary Brint (7th Grade Math Teacher)
 - Jacqueline Walker (School Counselor)
 - Rachel Gomberg (Spanish Teacher) through Medx
